



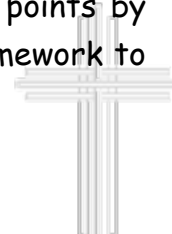
Year 5 Newsletter

Moonstone and Tangerine

Topic overview

PE	<p>We will be focussing on cricket skills and athletics activities.</p> <p>The children will learn how to set targets and improve their performance in a range of running, jumping and throwing activities. We will think about how to achieve the greatest possible height, distance or accuracy.</p>
Music	<p>The children will take part in drumming workshop, to work on rhythm and performance skills. We will also be studying jazz music from the 1920's.</p>
Art and design	<p>The children will continue to improve their sketching techniques concentrating this term on drawing buildings.</p>
Geography	<p>We will continue to explore our mountains topic, then move on to looking at two contrasting localities: Stockton and Whitby.</p>
RE	<p>This half term we are finding out Pentecost and what happened next. The final half term we will be studying the women of old testament.</p>
PSHE and citizenship	<p>The children will take part in sessions discussing the following themes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participation • Local democracy • Voluntary groups • Fund-raising activities • Comfortable and uncomfortable feelings • Problems in relationships • Anti-bullying • Help and support

Homework - is given out each half term. The children are expected to 'earn' 16 points by completing a range of different task from the homework menu. We expect the homework to be handed in by 23.5.18



Reading - Children need to read to an adult at least 3 times a week and have a signature for each time they have read, indicating the page they got up to, with a comment. This will be checked every Monday and books changed when appropriate.

PE - Monday and Thursday

Indoor kit: white/black shorts, white t-shirt and plimsolls.

Outdoor kit: tracksuit bottoms, t-shirt, tracksuit top, trainers.

As the kit used depends on the weather, we ask that a complete set is left in school, which can be taken home for washing when necessary.

If you have an important message regarding your child, please make sure that this is recorded in their contact book and handed in to the class teacher.

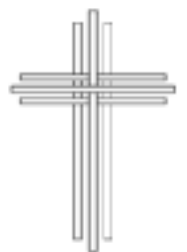
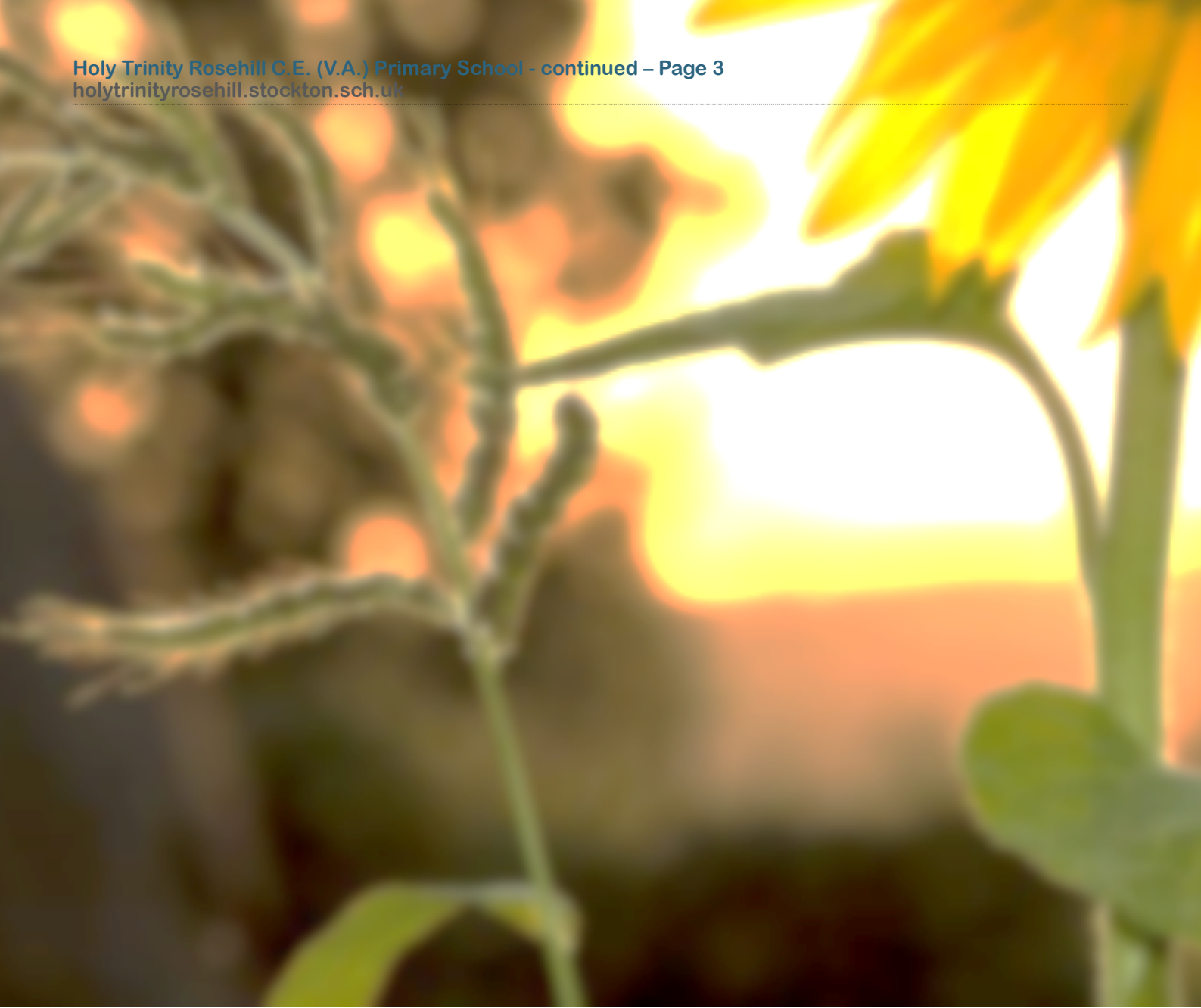
We want to keep school uniform looking smart, safe and clean could you ensure that your child's property is labelled.
