### Nursery - Rainbow Class

Hello and welcome to Nursery! We have had a lovely start to the year meeting our new starters and welcoming back some of our older children. The children are settling into Nursery brilliantly and they are all so eager to learn and explore.

#### Topic

Our topic for the first half term is 'All About Me'. We are learning all about our feelings, our family, our likes and dislikes and what makes everyone unique and special. The topic after half term will be 'Transport'. During this half term we will also be preparing for Christmas!

#### Reading

We love reading and sharing stories together! If you read one book with your child every day, they will have read 1825 books by their fifth birthday! At Holy Trinity Rosehill, we would love it if you could share a story with your child at least 3 times a week. We will be looking at our favourite stories as part of our 'All About Me' topic.

#### PE

We are lucky enough to have a sports coach, Jack, come in every Thursday to teach Nursery a range of games and skills. We will also be spending time in our outdoor area where children will be working on their balance and coordination. Nursery children do not need a PE kit.

#### Uniform

A little reminder that our uniform is grey trousers / joggers or grey skirt / pinafore with a blue polo shirt and a burgundy jumper or cardigan. Shoes must be black, preferably velcro or buckles rather than laces to encourage independent shoe fastening. Please ensure that all pieces of uniform are clearly labelled with your child's name.

Earrings are not to be worn. If your child has recently had their ears pierced and you are waiting for them to heal before they can be removed, please cover earrings with surgical tape to help prevent any injuries occurring from the jewellery being caught at school.

## Information

As the cold weather approaches, please make sure that your child has suitable clothing (waterproof coat, hat, mittens and wellies) as we go outside whatever the weather. Thank you to those of you who have sent in the weekly £1 voluntary contribution, we really appreciate it as it helps us to purchase resources to make play dough and to buy nice items for the writing areas.
