

## Cognition and Learning

- Experienced and knowledgeable subject leaders to support learning in all areas.
- Regular, individually focused intervention - Catch Up reading, 1:1 reading, touch typing with a teacher and/or teaching assistant.
- Increased access to small group support - extended writing groups, maths groups, keywords support, Y6 Target group, K.S. 1 Hamster group.
- Phonics intervention groups - Letters and Sounds, Direct Phonics, Beat Dyslexia, S.N.I.P.
- Practical aids for learning:- table squares, time/number lines, Cuisenaire, pictures, photos, accessible reading material suited to age, writing slopes, special writing implements to aid fine motor skills, word cards, visual timetables.
- Enhanced access to technical aids - spell checkers, I pads, laptops, computers.
- Adaptations to assessments to enable access e.g. readers, scribe, ICT, extra time.
- Curriculum and delivery will be adapted to meet the learning needs of the child - enlarged resources, colour of backgrounds.
- Frequent repetition and reinforcement, delivered in different ways to help pupils gain an understanding of what is being taught.
- Internal diagnostic assessment and testing to identify needs of the child.
- I.T. based intervention - Lexia, Mathletics.
