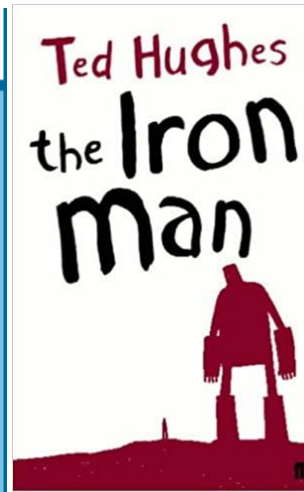
Use the clues in the first chapter to draw what you think the Iron Man looks like. Annotate your picture with descriptive words. This will be your plan.

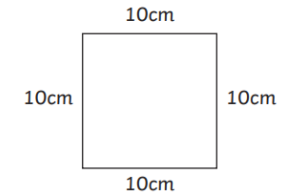

MATHS - LENGTH & PERIMETER

The **perimeter** is the distance all the way around the **outside** of a 2D shape.

To work out the perimeter, add up the lengths of all the sides.



$$10\text{cm} + 10\text{cm} + 10\text{cm} + 10\text{cm} = 40\text{cm}$$
