## Maths

### Monday – 10x tables (including division)

Write out the 10x table including division facts up to 12 x 10 = 120 and 120 divided by 10 = 12. Can you learn these?

**Tuesday and Wednesday** – Column subtraction without borrowing. Make up your own column subtractions where there is *no need to borrow*. (see Maths activities box)

**Thursday and Friday** – Column subtraction *with borrowing*. Make up your own column subtractions where there *is a need to borrow*.

## English Activities

### **Spellings**
