Please find below a number of updates from school – and a couple of surveys to complete please.

School uniform for September 2020

Our Governing Body adopted our revised Uniform Policy last week – I have attached a copy with this letter and a copy can be found on the policies page of our website www.holytrinityrosehill.org.uk/about/policies

Please note our expectations around uniform.

Our school uniform colour is a combination of pale blue, burgundy and grey. Most items can be bought from High Street shops. Items marked with a * below, some of which have the school logo on, are available from our on-line uniform supplier My Clothing www.myclothing.com/ueslink/23407.school

For every item that is purchased via My Clothing school **receives 5% donation**. Orders are delivered to your **home address and within 14 days**.

Everyday Uniform

- Grey skirt/pinafore dress/shorts/trousers Please note skirts should be an appropriate length and of a style which allows girls to sit comfortably on the floor.
- Optional blue and white checked dresses for wear in summer months only
- Pale blue polo shirt*
- Burgundy sweatshirt* or cardigan*, **without a hood**, either plain or with logo (with the exception of Y6 Leavers Hoodies)
- Plain white/grey/black short or knee length socks (not over the knee) or plain black or plain grey tights
- Plain black shoes or ankle boots in winter months. Children should wear shoes which he or she can manage to fasten independently. During inclement weather children may wear 'wellies' to school and bring their school shoes to change into once in school

P.E. Kit

Children need a change of clothes and footwear for P.E (for health and hygiene reasons) and a draw-string school PE bag in which to keep the kit at school. PE kit and PE bags may be bought from our uniform supplier. All school uniform and P.E. kit **MUST** be named. Children can become upset as a result of lost clothing, please help us by naming everything.

- black shorts
- plain white T-shirt
- a pair of plimsolls – Velcro fastenings are essential for younger children
- trainers for outdoor learning
- black jogging bottoms and black zip up jacket for outdoor lessons in cold weather

From September, as mentioned in monthly newsletter previous to March 2020, we kindly request that children bring a school **Book Bag and PE bag** into school – not large backpacks. This is particularly important in the light of our Risk Assessment for full opening in September when children should only bring the absolute essential equipment in from home - more details to follow.
