A few gentle reminders.....

- Drop-off and collection - Thank you for following the routes and systems to drop off and collect your child(ren) today. Please remember to leave our gate areas and yards quickly and we kindly request that adults do not congregate near our crossing or near school gates - this will help other families to drop off and collect children easily. During collection at the end of the school day, please use our one way system on Rosehill site.
- Dinner money – Please help our office staff by sending payment into school on the first day of your child's attendance in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name, class, date and the amount enclosed. Dinner money is currently £2.05 per day, £10.25 per week. Cheques are preferable made payable to Stockton Borough Council. Payments can be weekly, half termly, or termly.
- Packed lunches - Many of our children are bringing their own packed lunches from home. Please be aware that we predict this will be for the rest of this half term. If they wish to change back to a school lunch, please let the school know at least 2 weeks before the end of half term.
- Personal belongings - Please name all packed lunch boxes and water bottles. Today we had one unclaimed lunch box and, when asked, the children did not know who it belonged to! Please also remember that all children's clothing should also be named as school jumpers and coats can easily become mixed up!
