Exploration, discovery and adventure- what everyday changes can make a difference?



This term in Year 1 and 2, we will be travelling back in time to 1666 to explore the Great Fire of London. Could history have been different if we had known more about materials? Let us explore and discover!

In Literacy, we will continue to explore exciting texts looking at narratives about personal experiences and those of others (real and fictional), writing about real events, poetry and writing for different purposes. We will continue extending writing and using phonics to support reading as well as Y2s looking at spelling patterns and adjectives.

In Maths, Year One will be continuing to develop their knowledge of place value to 50, moving onto 100. We will then be working on our multiplication, division, money and time skills. Year Two children will be consolidating their learning on multiplication and division, moving onto working on fractions, geometry, measurement and time.

As Theologists, we will be developing our understanding of Judaism through learning stories from the Torah. We will also be exploring the good news brought by Jesus.

Geography:



As Geographers, we will be using atlases and globes to develop our mapping skills as well as using compasses and directional language to describe the location and features of a map.

As Artists, we will be investigating colour and textures, experimenting with changing the consistency of materials. We will also be using clay to create our own masterpieces.

As active members of Year One and Two, we will continue to work with Durham Cricket Club to master our cricket skills.

Science:



As Scientists, we will be identifying and classifying materials and looking into how and why things have changed over time.

As Computing Technologists, we will be beginning to understand what algorithms are linking this to instruction writing.
