Maths: First, we will add and subtract fractions and calculate quantities of amounts. Then we will explore decimals: understanding tenths, hundredths and thousands. We will also order and compare decimals. For our money topic, we will order money, round money and solve problems and even link fractions and decimals to money. In Summer term 2, we will move on to finding out about time, statistics and end the term with geometry.

French:



We will learning how to describe clothing in French. Additionally, we will talk about what type of clothes we have and use conjunctions. We will also continue to introduce ourselves and count.
