

## Literacy

Look at meaningful print such as your child's name, words on a cereal box or book title, or icons on a weather app. Discuss similarities and differences between symbols.

## Maths

On walks, in pictures or while playing, point out how things or people that are far away look smaller.

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Model how you manage your own feelings. E.g. "I'm feeling a bit angry and I need to calm down so I'm going to..."

## Expressive Art and Design

Discuss changes in movement and sound. If you turn the volume up on the TV or radio, does the sound get louder or quieter? Talk about what's happening to help your child think about cause and effect.

## Communication and Language

Add words to what your child says to encourage the use of full sentences. E.g. If your child says, "Brush doll hair" say, "Yes, you are brushing doll's hair."

## Physical Development

Do up zips on coats etc from behind / over your child's shoulder so they can see the process from their perspective.

## Understanding the World

Use the correct names for plants, animals and geographical features. E.g. Cow not Moo Cow, Horse not Horsey, saying the name of a flower e.g. rose rather than just flower.

### Religious Education




In RE we will be learning about Harvest Festival and later in the term we will explore why Christians perform the Nativity.

We will be working on our gross motor and fine motor skills by painting large pictures, playing with play dough and threading beads.
