English



In English, we will be reading 'Letters from the Lighthouse' and exploring the themes within this book. We will further develop our writing skills, including biographies, letters, diaries and newspaper reports. We will also be exploring a range of poetry. We will be revising and developing our understanding of SPAG concepts.

Maths



In Maths, we will be working on developing written methods of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, further developing our understanding of place value to 10,000,000 and extending our understanding of fractions. In geometry, we will be studying position and direction. We will be continually practising and extending our arithmetic skills.

Religious Education



As Theologists, we will be explaining connections between biblical texts and the concept of the Kingdom of God. We will also consider how Christians put their beliefs into practice in a variety of ways.

We will be exploring the meanings of Gospel texts and become aware of how texts can be interpreted differently.
