English



Our English work this term is planned around the fiction book 'Stone Age Boy' and links with our History topic. Our activities include writing a set of instructions, which include command sentences. We will also be using our imagination to write a narrative with emphasis on character description. And using fronted adverbials. Word types we are focusing on this term are noun, verb, and adjective.

Maths

Place Value



- count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100; find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number
- recognise the place value of each digit in a 3-digit number (100s, 10s, 1s)
- read and write numbers up to 1,000 in numerals and in words

Addition and Subtraction

Add and subtract numbers with up to 3 digits, using formal written methods of columnar addition and subtraction

Multiplication and Division

- learn 2x, 5x and 10x tables including division facts for quick recall
- write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication using the multiplication tables

Religious Education



What kind of world did Jesus want? Matthew 4 (18-22)

Identify this as part of a 'Gospel', which tells the story of the life and teaching of Jesus.

Make links between the Bible stories studied and the importance of love, and life in the world today

Advent

Identify the main beliefs at the heart of religious festivals.
