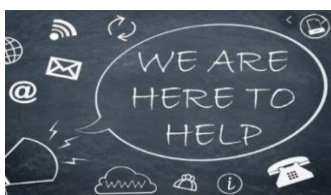
Help and support

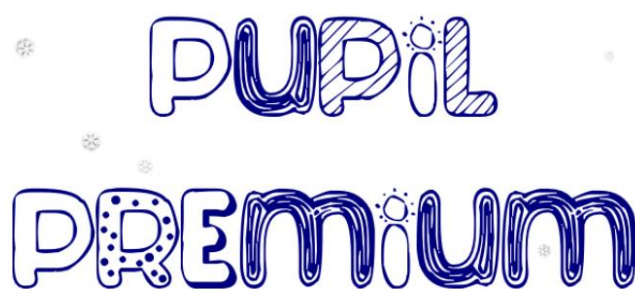

Pupil Premium survey January 2022

Introduced in 2011, the Pupil Premium is a sum of money given to schools each year by the Government to improve the attainment of children.

Primary schools are given a pupil premium for:

- Children in Reception to Year 6 who are currently entitled to free school meals based on their family income
- Children in Reception to Year 6 who were previously entitled to benefits-based free school meals, even if they're no longer eligible:
- Children in care
- Children previously in care who have been adopted, or who have a special guardianship order, a child arrangements order or a residence order
- Children recorded as being from service families



Schools can choose how to spend their pupil premium money, as they are best placed to identify what would be of most benefit to the children who are eligible.

We would like to ensure that our school is receiving all the Pupil Premium money we are entitled to and ask for your help in order to do this.

We kindly ask that you supply the following information so that we can check if your child/ren is/are entitled to Free School Meals: parent/carer name, parent/carer date of birth and parent/carer National Insurance number.

Every parent/carer that completes this survey will be entered into a prize draw to win £50 supermarket voucher.

Please complete the survey by Tuesday 18th January 12 noon. The parent/carer who wins the voucher will be informed by Friday 21st January.

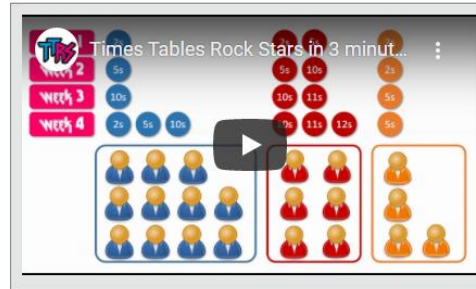
We're excited to share that every child in **KS2 (Y3-Y6)** now has a Times Tables Rock Stars account!

What is Times Tables Rock Stars?

In either paper form or online, Times Tables Rock Stars is a carefully sequenced programme of daily times tables practice.

Each week concentrates on a different times table, with a recommended consolidation week for rehearsing the tables that have recently been practised every third week or so.

This format has very successfully boosted times tables recall speed for hundreds of thousands of pupils over the last 8 years in over 16,000 schools - both primary and secondary - worldwide.



Go to <https://play.ttrockstars.com/login/20137> and enter their username and password which can be found in their contact book. Your child will complete the baseline assessment in school before they are able to access at home.

Please remind your child not to share their login details. If you have any difficulties logging in or questions about TT Rock Stars in general, please contact school (not Times Tables Rock Stars themselves).

We hope this will be a fun and engaging way for your children to learn their times tables and celebrate their success. Please encourage your child to use this programme regularly at home and complete at least 2 sessions each week.

FAQs

My child seems to be getting questions up to 12x12 - why is that?

Assuming that's not intentional, make sure they're playing in the Garage or Arena to get the tables we've set for them.

Why can't we login?

The most likely cause is that one of the three bits of information (school, username or password) hasn't been entered as above.

My child has chosen a rock name they're unhappy with - how do we change it?

Ask your child's teacher to reset their rock name so they can choose again when they login.

My child is unhappy with the look of their avatar - what can be done?

Everyone starts with the same avatar, no matter what rock name they've chosen. Simply change the hair, eyes and mouth to suit individual preferences.

Someone has logged in as my child and spent a load of their coins - what can we do?

Let your child's teacher know so that they can refund your child and speak to the class about trust and online safety.
