

Literacy

Encourage your child to predict outcomes of stories, think of alternative endings and compare feelings of characters with their own experiences.

Maths

Model and encourage counting and representing numbers e.g. making a phone call using a list of numbers and by writing numerals on badges or birthday cards.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Allow your child for their ideas on what might make people feel better when they are sad or cross.

How to help at home

Expressive Art and Design

Encourage children to notice changes in properties of media e.g. paint flaking when dry. Talk about what's happening and help them understand cause and effect.

Communication and Language

Expand on what children say by repeating it and adding a few more words, helping children to use more complex sentences.

Physical Development

Encourage your child to notice changes in their body after exercise, such as their heart beating faster.

Have a look at the minibeasts around your garden or local area. Look up what they are called and what they like to do.

In Communication and Language we will be showing understanding of prepositions such as under, on top and behind.
