Everything Changes – what changes have happened in our world and how can we make a difference in the future?

English



In Literacy this term we will be focussing hard on our reading, writing and phonics skills. We will explore traditional tales such as Billy Goat's Gruff and Little Red Riding Hood, using these as a basis for our own writing. We will be developing our recount writing skills, using real life experiences as a stimulus. Throughout the Summer term, we will also focus on the importance of instructions and the vocabulary associated with this style of writing. We will also explore poetry and the language we use to entertain our audiences.

Maths



In Maths, Year One children will be building on their place value skills and applying this to multiplication and division. As well as this, they will be consolidating their new skills from the Spring Term. Year Two children will developing their skills in fractions, measuring and understanding time. They will consolidate their understanding of shape from the Spring Term and also focus on our arithmetic and problem solving questions.

Religious Education



As Theologists, Year 1 and 2 will be learning about Islam, who a Muslim is and how they live their lives. We intend to use our locality to experience a visit to a Mosque and use this to deepen our understanding of other religions in our community. During the Summer term we will also reflect on the 'good news' that Christians believe Jesus brings and give accounts of what Bible texts also mean to Christians.

As active members of Year 1 and 2, we will construct and perform dances using simple movement patterns. This will link to our listening of high quality music.

As Geographers, we will explore and compare the similarities and differences with the UK and a non European country. Our discoveries along the way will link to our history learning.

Science



As Scientists, we will continue to explore seasonal changes and use our locality to explore this further. We will also be investigating the world of plants and recapping materials. This will link to our learning in art.

D.T



As Designers, we will be developing our skills in textiles – measuring accurately whilst cutting and joining accurately to make a product. Through Art, DT and Science we will be experimenting with the art of dying using natural products from the outdoors.

History



As Historians, we will be looking in more depth and changes over the years. We will look in more details at holidays and destinations both locally and in the world. Next, we will explore the wonderful world of toys and what they can tell us about changes.

Languages



As linguists, Year 1 and 2 will be continuing to listen to and explore French songs, rhymes and basic phrases.

Computing



As Computing Technologists, we will be creating and debugging simple programs together. We will create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content through apps such as iMovie. We will continue to build on our team work skills by working together and sharing ideas through projects.
