Religious Education

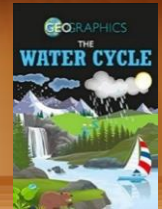
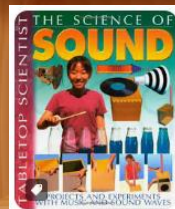


As Theologists, we will be finding out what it means to be a Hindu, and we will also be thinking about why Christians call the day Jesus died Good Friday.
