What is an advocate?

An advocate is someone that **supports a cause**.

These causes often either contain people that **struggle to speak up for themselves** (e.g. homeless people) or is something that **not many people know about**.

For example, Greta Thunberg is an advocate for **climate change**. She **uses her voice** to speak out about how we need to look after our planet. She protests in the street, speaks at big events and shares her thoughts about this on her Twitter account.

There are many things in this world that people need to advocate on behalf of them. You may have seen some of them in the news this year.
