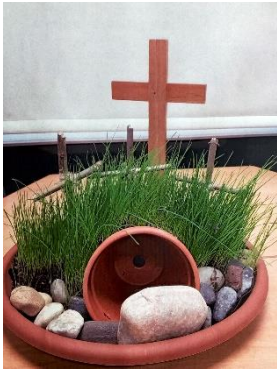

KS1 Easter Gardens

The children in Year 1/2 made Easter Resurrection Gardens as part of their RE work in the run up to Easter. They were placed in the classrooms and on their worship tables.



The grass, grown from seed grew well with frequent watering, and they looked so lovely that Mrs Roberts asked if she could take them to her church, St. Barnabas, Linthorpe and Ayresome, Middlesbrough to be part of their decorations for Easter.



The gardens were first seen on Good Friday, exactly as the children had made them, though a little grass trimming was done by Mary, the flower team organiser and Jessica, her little helper, as pictured, so that the crosses could be seen.



For Easter Day, to celebrate Jesus rising from the dead, the stones in front of the tombs were removed and replaced by a flowering plant. Again Jessica did a bit of careful trimming to help them look at their best.
