#### Religious Education

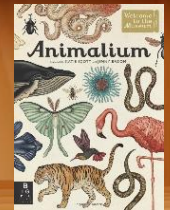
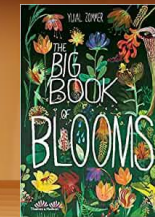
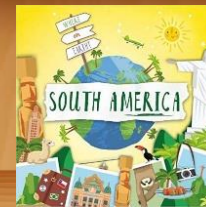
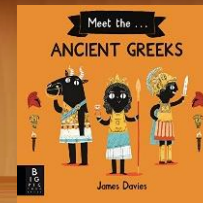
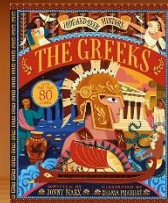


As theologians, we will be exploring how following God can bring freedom and justice and thinking about what will make our local community a more respectful place.
