### Religious Education

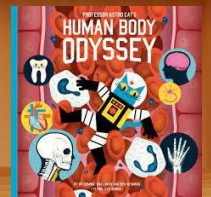
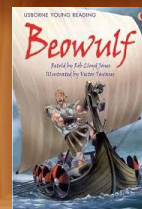


As Theologists, we will find out how and why believers show their commitments during the journey of life. We will also learn about the meaning of Trinity.
