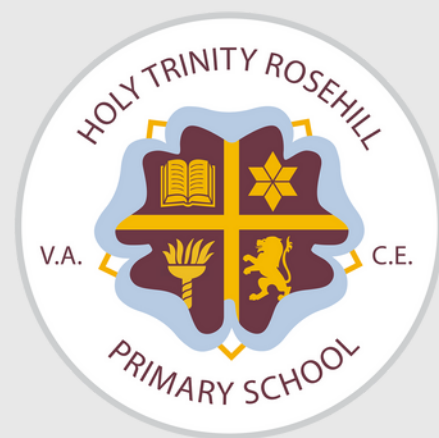

Start date and Timings

Nursery opens on
Tuesday 5th September.

15 hour sessions
Morning 8.45am to 8.55am drop off
– 11.45 am
Afternoon 12.30pm to 12.40pm drop off
– 3.30 pm
30 hour sessions
8.45 am – 2.45pm

Initial starting dates may be staggered
so children can feel settled and secure.
Children are encouraged to find their
name tag and matching peg so they can
hang up their own coat.

Nursery Refreshments

Nursery children are offered milk or
water and a piece
of fruit during each session.

Please can your child come to school
with a filled water bottle each day.

Nursery Meals 30 Hours Provision

Nursery lunch will be between 12 and
12.30pm. The children will eat their packed
lunch or school lunch in the hall and are
supervised at all times.

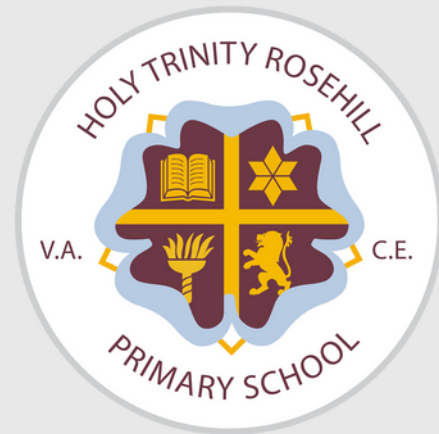
Please keep us updated regarding any

Many learning experiences occur outside. Children are encouraged to be explorers, be physical in a variety of ways and take managed risks which promote confidence and imaginative play.

We play outside in all weathers and will let you know if we need wellies.

How can you help?

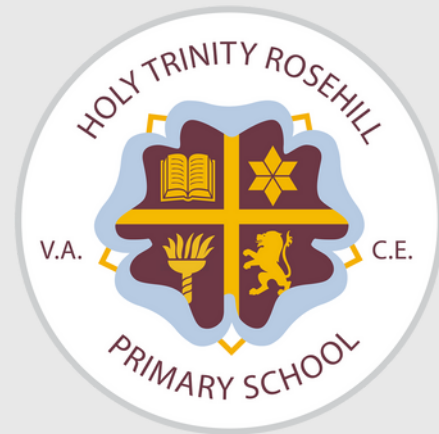
Early Years children love to be independent so please encourage your child to put on their own clothes, use the toilet and wash their hands. (We will support with these tasks in school.)

Share a book with your child every day and talk about the pictures and the characters. Provide mark making equipment and have conversations about what they draw or write. Look for numbers in the environment, count steps, cups, shoes and tins. Ask "What is one more?"
Guess how many socks in the drawer then count and check.

What to do if your child is unwell

If your child is going to be absent from school, please ensure that you phone the school office and leave a voicemail on our children's absence voicemail (Option 2 for Rosehill Site children).

If your child has vomited or has had an upset tummy, they must remain off school until they are 48 hours clear from their last bout of sickness.

Medicine should be administered at home, however if medicine has been prescribed four times a day by a doctor, one dose may be administered at school by school staff. Please complete the Medication Form from school.

If your child is required to attend a medical appointment, please provide evidence of the appointment.

We are looking forward to welcoming your child to our Nursery at Holy Trinity Rosehill CofE Primary School.
