### English



In English, Year 1 will continue to develop their phonics knowledge using ELS. In writing, the children will begin to write captions and sentences linked to stories.

In Year 2, we will do daily spelling lessons linked to our phonics scheme - ELS.

In writing, we will focus on writing sentences correctly that are sequenced to form short narratives. We will focus on our handwriting by forming letters correctly and learn to join in Year 2.

### Maths



In Maths, Year One children we will be working on their place value skills and developing their addition and subtraction knowledge. Year Two children will be building on their place value knowledge to learn more about addition and subtraction, and begin to think about multiplication.

### Religious Education

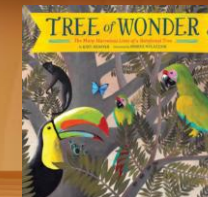
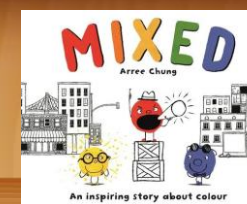
