English



Our English work this term is planned around our History topic on Romans. We will be writing newspaper reports and narratives, focusing on setting and character description and integrating dialogue. We will focus on description using expanded noun phrases and expanding our sentences using a wider range of conjunctions.

Maths



In Maths, we will be working on place value. We will be counting, recognising and representing numbers to 1000. We will build our confidence of using written methods for addition and subtraction and develop our understanding of multiplication and division including learning times tables up to 12x12.

Religious Education
