Religious Education

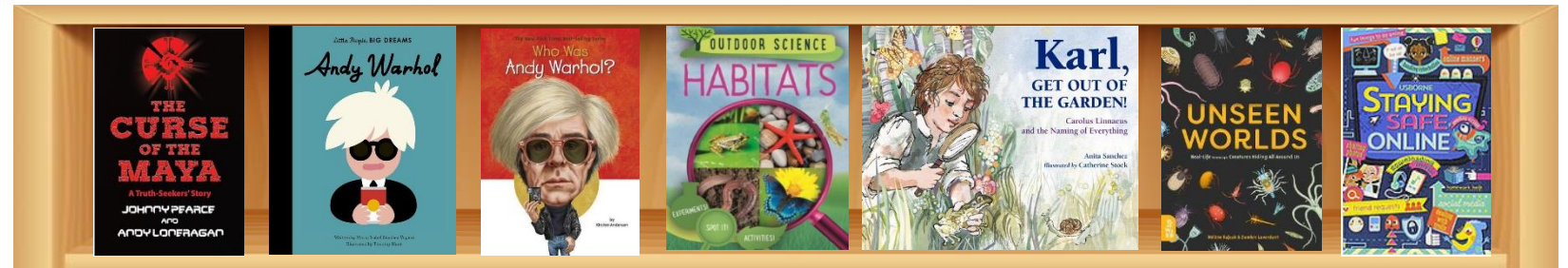
